Our house fairy tale The Golden Goat

Once upon a time there was a boy who went into the forest to gather berries. He turned right and left and collected his basket full. He didn't notice how the sun was slowly setting and night was falling. At the edge of the forest he saw a hut. Then the boy

said, "I think I will go and see who lives in it." When he knocked on the door, an old woman opened it. She invited the child in and gave him food and drink. When the boy was sated, she stoked the fire and said:

"It is said that not far from here once lived a mighty king. His castle with its mighty walls stood high up on the "Iron 'Mountain", surrounded by a dark forest. No path and no way led to that castle.

Leisure activities in Korbach and its surroundings:

- Take one of the guided tours through the historic old town or take advantage of the many shopping opportunities in the beautiful pedestrian zone.
- You can discover Korbach's past in the new Korbach Museum, which has won awards for its architecture. Here you will not only find interesting facts of Korbach's town history, but also separate sections for gold mining in Goldhausen. Also there were many fossil finds of the "Korbacher Spalte" (a big fissure with many fossil finds).
- ➤ Visit the 250-million-year-old "Korbacher Spalte", which became world-famous among archaeologists because of the archeological find of the Procynosuchus ("Korbach dog"). An archeological find with long-range consequences. Free guided tours always on Sunday mornings.
- ➤ The "Eisenberg" (iron mountain) is Germany's richest gold deposit. It is Korbach's tourist highlight with ist gold trail and visitor tunnel (open from May to October)





- ➤ The heath blossom festival or the blueberry harvest are great opportunities to get to know the impressive Waldeck Upland with the highest mountains in the Hochsauerland.
- ➤ Drive through the charming "Waldecker Land", the "Ederbergland" and visit the new "Kellerwald-Edersee National Park"

➤ Visit the largest ski jump in the world in the romantic valley "Strycktal" in Willingen.
